	Construct and Instruct Troop on use of a safe axe-yard. (This makes a great instructional opportunity)
PATROL METHOD	
	CONDUCT DAILY PATROL LEADERS' COUNCIL MEETINGS
	HAVE CLEAR EVIDENCE OF USE OF THE PATROL METHOD (example: Patrol Flags Posted, Tents grouped by Patrols etc)
	PATROLS PARTICIPATE IN AT LEAST 3 ACTIVITIES AS A PATROL (example: Patrol Hike, Swim by Patrols, Patrol Campfire, etc)
	Build Camp Gadgets for the Campsite
TROOP PARTICIPATION	
	HAVE ATTENDED SM/APL ORIENTATION OR ATTEND CHAPEL DAILY
	PARTICIPATE IN AT LEAST TWO TROOP ACTIVITIES
	COMPLETE A TROOP CONSERVATION OR SERVICE PROJECT WHILE IN CAMP (See Camp Commissioner or Nature Area Director for information)
	POST A TROOP DUTY ROSTER AND SCHEDULES IN THE CAMPSITE
	TROOP SHOWS SCOUT SPIRIT (Cheers, yells etc)
	Perform troop flag ceremonies daily
	Participate in the Knot-off
	Construct a campsite gateway or entrance
ADULT LEADERSHIP	
	LEADERS MUST BE TRAINED IN SAFE SWIM DEFENSE & SAFETY AFLOAT
	ALL LEADERS MUST BE TRAINED IN YOUTH PROTECTION
