**PLEASE NOTE:**

Waste cans must have plastic liners. Camp Commissioners have these. When full, tie the bag closed and place it in one of the large barrels located along camp roads.

When checking out, be sure all trash is in barrels on roads, platforms are leaned neatly against trees in the campsite with smooth side out, tents are folded and stacked in washstand, and all other equipment is checked in to Quartermaster. **Leave dining flies up for next week.**

**We do not rake or disturb the ground cover at Camp Pirtle to prevent dust and erosion.** All litter is picked up by hand. Fires are permitted only in designated areas. Do not cut, chop or drive nails into trees.

Showers are located in three areas of the campsite section of camp and at the swimming pool. Each troop should do its part in keeping showers clean and sanitary. Adult leaders will be issued a combination to a restroom with hot water and an electrical outlet for shaving.
